YARN REQUIREMENTS

**YARN IS HELD DOUBLE
THROUGHOUT.**

400 yards worsted weight yarn

OTHER MATERIALS

US 13 (9.0 mm) circular needle, or size needed
to obtain gauge

Stitch markers (2)

Cable needle

Tapestry needle for weaving in ends

GAUGE

11 stitches and 14 rows = 4" in stockinette
stitch

ABBREVIATIONS

st(s): stitch(es)

k: knit

p: purl

ktbl: k through the back loop

ptbl: p through the back loop

RS: right (public) side of the work

WS: wrong (private) side of the work

C1/1L: Place next st on cable needle and hold
in front, k1, k1 from cable needle

C1/1R: Place next st on cable needle and hold
in back, k1, k1 from cable needle

C2/1L: Place next 2 sts on cable needle and
hold in front, k1, k2 from cable needle

C2/1R:

On the RS: Place next st on cable needle and
hold in back, k2, k1 from cable needle

On the WS: Place next 2 sts on cable needle and
hold in back, p1, p2 from cable needle
