



COTTONWOOD POCKET COMFORT

MATERIALS

15 grams (60 yards) fingering weight yarn
US 2 (2.75mm) knitting needles
Tapestry needle for weaving in ends

ABBREVIATIONS

st(s): stitch(es)
k: knit
p: purl
RS: right (public) side of work

Cast on 28 sts.

BOTTOM BORDER

Knit 6 rows.

BODY

Row 1 (RS): k all sts.

Row 2 (WS): k3, work (p1, k1) to last 3 sts, k3.

Row 3 (RS): k all sts

Row 4 (WS): k3, work (k1, p1) to last 3 sts, k3.

Work Rows 1-4 twelve (12) times total.

TOP BORDER

Knit 6 rows.

Bind off all sts. Weave in ends securely.
